SUBMISSIONS

Submission of a manuscript is representation that the paper has neither been published nor submitted for publication elsewhere, and that, if the work is officially sponsored, it has been released for open publication. For papers that are accepted, the authors (or their employers—whoever holds the copyright) will be required to sign and send to the editor-in-chief an *Assignment of Copyright* form (available from the journal's website), transferring the copyright to INFORMS. If there are multiple authors, only one author's signature is needed on the *Assignment of Copyright* form, and it may be faxed to the editor-in-chief, or a scanned graphics file of it after it has been signed may be e-mailed to the editor-in-chief.

As a condition of final acceptance of a paper for publication in *INFORMS Journal on Computing*, the author(s) must indicate if their paper is posted on a working paper website, other than their own. They are responsible for assuring that, if any part of the paper has been copyrighted for prepublication as a working paper, the copyright can and will be transferred to INFORMS when the paper has been accepted. This includes both print and electronic forms of the paper. Authors should submit manuscripts directly to the appropriate area editor, or to the editor-in-chief if there is question about which area is appropriate. Papers should not be submitted to associate editors. There is no

a priori page limit for *JOC*, but conciseness and clarity of presentation are important.

Electronic submission is *strongly* encouraged, but authors should first check with the person to whom the submission will be sent to ensure compatibility of file types (e.g., PDF, PostScript, LaTeX, Word) and transmission mode (e.g., e-mail attachment with a particular encoding, anonymous FTP). If it is necessary to submit hardcopy, please send five copies of the manuscript and alert via e-mail the person to whom the submission is being made. When a paper is accepted, authors are also asked to transmit the electronic file containing the text of the paper, as well as electronic or high-quality original hardcopy of any figures.

OPEN ACCESS

Gold Option—The INFORMS Open Option (IOO) provides an open access alternative for articles accepted in any INFORMS journals that would have otherwise been available only through subscriptions or pay per view.

Green Option—Authors may post their author accepted manuscript (AAM) on personal websites immediately after acceptance, and may post AAMs in noncommercial institutional repositories 12 months after INFORMS publishes the final typeset version online; AAMs must include the DOI link provided by INFORMS to the version of record.
