Each year, the January-February issue of *Interfaces* is dedicated to the papers of the competition finalists of the Franz Edelman Award for Achievement in Operations Research and the Management Sciences. We are currently seeking nominations for Editor, Edelman Award special issue of *Interfaces*.

The editor serves a three-year term with the major responsibility of shepherding the Edelman papers through the editorial process to ensure that they are of the highest quality and meet the standards for publication in *Interfaces*. This involves working closely with the Edelman finalist teams on the content, style, clarity, and structure of their papers and making sure that the teams adhere to the production schedule for the January-February issue of *Interfaces*. The editor makes the ultimate decision on whether each Edelman finalist paper is acceptable for publication. The editor also serves as a judge ex officio in the Edelman competition held each year at the spring INFORMS practice meeting.
