Editor-in-Chief, *Management Science*
Deadline for Nominations: June 15, 2008

The final term of Wallace J. Hopp as editor-in-chief of the INFORMS journal *Management Science* expires on December 31, 2008. Based on recommendations from the INFORMS Publications Committee, the president of INFORMS has appointed a committee to conduct a full search for a new editor-in-chief. The committee intends to propose a candidate for approval by INFORMS no later than August 1, 2008.

All members of INFORMS are invited to participate in this process. The committee seeks your opinions and comments on (1) the current state of the journal, (2) recommendations for new directions, if any, and (3) candidates for editor-in-chief.

Qualifications for the editor-in-chief of *Management Science* will include:

- a demonstrated record of scholarship in the field of management science
- a commitment to support the broad range of topics in the field
- having a vision and a plan for enhancing the reputation and stature of *Management Science* and generally promoting the journal
- ability to manage the editorial process efficiently and effectively
- a clear understanding of the role of *Management Science* in today's digital world
- prior editorial experience
- commitment to the workload involved
- an ability and willingness to work with the INFORMS Publications Committee and the INFORMS Publications Department
