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New Book on Computers

An easy-to-understand text on modern computers has just been published by The Business Press, 288 Park Ave., West, Elmhurst, Illinois, the title, "Fundamentals of Digital Computers".

Six well-illustrated sections—introduction, programming, computer numbering systems, boolean algebra and basic logic building blocks, input/output equipment, and the central processor—present the complete computer story clearly and concisely.

Written by qualified members of the field engineering department of Sperry Rand's UNIVAC division, the book was originally intended only for internal use by UNIVAC staff people. Strong indications of interest by non-technical people outside the UNIVAC organization led to a decision to make copies generally available.

In its 116 pages are 85 illustrations, diagrams and tables. Each of the six sections is concluded with a refresher quiz to test understanding.

The book is priced at \$3.00 in the United States. Outside the U.S. the price is \$3.50.
