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Symposium at Princeton in August

The Sixth Symposium on Mathematical Programming (i.e., "linear programming" and related problems) will be held August 14-18, 1967, at Princeton University, Princeton, New Jersey, U.S.A. This international symposium will continue a series of research conferences begun in 1949 at Chicago and held last in 1964 at London. It will be devoted to the theory and applications of the mathematics of constrained optimization, including linear programming and its extensions to convex programming, general nonlinear programming, integer programming, dynamic programming, and network flow.

Please note that the Princeton Symposium is timed to follow the A.M.S. Summer Seminar on Math. of the Decision Sciences at Stanford, July 10-August 11 and precede the TIMS Meeting August 22-25 in Mexico City.

A five-day special summer program "Operations Research for Public Systems" will be presented at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology from September 5 through September 9, 1967.
