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Appreciation to Referees

THE EDITOR has been reminded by some of the Associate Editors that a list of those indispensable editorial collaborators who have acted as referees has not been published since December, 1956, and that these individuals certainly deserve direct SOCIETY acknowledgment of their services.

It is not desirable to publish lists of referees too frequently since it is important that the referees who act on particular papers remain anonymous. On the other hand, with the greatly increased number of papers being refereed (184 during 1958, of which 63 were accepted with or without modification, 56 rejected, and 65 still with referees at the end of the year or returned to the author for modification; as well as some 20 Letters to the Editor), such lists can be published with increasing frequency without danger of compromise.

Hence *the Editor and the Associate Editors take this opportunity to thank the following individuals who have acted as referees during the period January 1957–March 1959.* The JOURNAL, as well as the authors of many of the published papers, have benefited greatly from their critical reviews. Without their willing cooperation, it would be impossible for the SOCIETY to publish a journal of high professional standard.

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
